## **Surgery day**

**Fasting times must be adhered to** (you will be informed of any changes in time).

- Approx. 30 45 minutes before the operation, your child will receive the medication prescribed in the anaesthetic consultation in the form of a tablet / juice or suppository

- floor)
- In order for you to be able to join your child in the recovery room after the operation,
- it is important that you spend the waiting time on the ward in the patient's room.
- Only 1 parent (mum or dad) can enter the recovery room at any one time.
- The nurse in charge will tell you what your child is allowed to eat and drink after the operation. Please follow the instructions for the well-being of your child.
